## **Eagle Day at Lake Shelbyville**

**Lake Shelbyville**– The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Eagle Day event on Saturday, February 14, 2015 at the Lake Shelbyville Visitor Center. Treat your valentine to a free show celebrating our national symbol and other birds of prey!

New to Eagle Day this year, the Illinois Raptor Center will be presenting a short 30 minute program just for kids! Raptors for Kids begins at 10:00 a.m. There will also be two 50 minute Birds of Prey programs featuring a live bald eagle along with other live birds of prey. The first program starts at 11:00 a.m. and the second program will start at 1:00 p.m. There is no cost to attend the program, however only 150 seats will be available per showing. A portion of tickets for the programs will be available to be picked up in person on a first come first serve basis at the Lake Shelbyville Visitor Center during normal business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. beginning Monday, February 9, 2015. No more than 6 tickets per person can be reserved prior to the event date.
