CATEGORIES:

Parks & Recreation (ex: fishing, hunting, camping, boating, swimming, hiking, golfing)

Scenic (ex: the lake, the dam, beaches, sunsets, landscapes, flowers, etc.)

Wildlife (ex: in natural settings, birds, insects, animals) (NO HUMAN INTERACTION)

Faces at Places (ex: people enjoying activities, events, or attractions.) (More than one person)

RULES: All photos must have been taken at Lake Shelbyville or within Shelby County. Digital Photos must be 8 megapixels or above. The contest is open to everyone except SCOT & U. S. Army Corps of Engineers employees. Each individual photographer may enter up to two photographs in each category. No print on picture including timestamps. **An entry form must accompany each digital photograph.** SCOT reserves the right to refuse entries. (ex: poor resolution, questionable content)

All entries become the property of the Shelby County Office of Tourism.
Prizes to be awarded: Overall Grand Prize and a First Prize in each category.
